## **Weather forecast summary:**


As per the forecast issued by India Meteorological Department, the sky will remain variably to mainly cloudy with possibility of very light rainfall at isolated places mainly between 18 – 20 May. The maximum temperature may range between 34 to 36 °C and minimum temperature may range between 17 to 18 °C for next five days. Relative humidity may range between 25 to 80%. Wind may blow mainly in the North Eastern (NE) direction with the average speed of 1-2 km/hour.

Warning: No Warning.

**General Advisory:** Possibility of very light rainfall at isolated places over the district mainly between 18 - 20 May.

**SMS Advisory:** Farmers are advised to shift the harvested produce to safer place from crop fields or cover them with tarpaulin sheets as rainfall expected between 18-20 May at some places over the district.

Extended Range Forecast System: As per Extended Range Forecast System (ERFS), rainfall activity is likely to be large deficit between 17<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> May over Jammu division.
