

# Jammu: The City of Temples

The charming state of Jammu was founded by King Jambu Lochan in the 14th century and has been the seat of the powerful Dogra dynasty in the bygone times. Enclosed by the snow-capped Pir Panjal Mountains, Jammu is blessed with such awe-inspiring beauty which has rendered many painters and poets speechless. It is a land where the ancient and pristine Tawi river flows in full vigour, where you can never have enough of the touristy places that have been present since centuries. Maa Vaishno Devi temple is one of the holiest Hindu pilgrimages and is a must visit place. Some other important places of interest in Jammu are: Ranbireshwar temple, Raghunath temple, Bawe wali Mata, Bahu fort & gardens, Mohmaya temple, Lakshmi Narayan temple, Jamwant gufa, Amar mahal palace, Sudh Mahadev temple, Gauri kund, Surinsar and Mansar Lake, Purmandal and Indo-pak border.



# **Accommodation**

We are in the final stage of confirming list of hotels to be used for accommodation of delegates in ISVMCON-2025. Once a list of hotels is finalized it will be communicated to all the delegates well in advance so that they can book accommodation in hotel of their choice. Limited accommodation for delegates will be arranged in university quest house on first cum first serve basis on payment. Accommodation in star rated hotels in Jammu can also be made at their own cost. Tentative tariff range will be from Rs. 1500/- 5000/day/room (on share basis in double occupancy). The students (boys/girls) registered by key date will be considered for dormitory accommodation at nominal cost in university or any safe government premises.

#### How to reach Jammu

Jammu is well connected to the major cities and other parts of India by air, rail and road. It also has an airport and main railway station in Jammu city. The temperature in Jammu in February will be comfortable with low of 11°C and high up to 23°C. Moderate/light winter clothing will be required.

#### **Transport**

All possible efforts will be made for providing transport facility to the delegates coming for ISVMCON-2025 from hotels to conference venue and vice versa. However, a mutual cooperation will be highly appreciated.
