

Vice Chancellor SKUAST-J inaugurated Four Day Agrifest

A four day Agri-Fest 'Kairos-2' commenced here today on 04-12-2018 in the Chatha campus of SKUAST-J. The event is a four-day festival comprising quiz, literary, cultural and sports events etc. The programme is being conducted under the able-chairmanship of Dr D.P Abrol, Dean Faculty of Agriculture.
