Notice Inviting e-tender

On behalf of SKUAST-Jammu, tender is hereby invited through e-tendering mode from the manufacturers, reputed and authorized distributors/ dealers/suppliers/firms for purchase of equipment as per details given in **Annexure-I**

1. The Bidding documents/NIT can be downloaded from the website <http://jktenders.gov.in> from 14-01-2025 (10:00 AM) to 03-02-2025 up to 4:00 P.M.
2. a) The bids shall be deposited in electronic format on the website <http://jktenders.gov.in> from 14-01-2025 (10:00 AM) to 03-02-2025 up to 4:00 P.M. The bids received will be opened on or after 04-02-2025 at 11:00 AM. Technical bids of only those bidders will be considered that fulfill the pre-eligibility conditions by the evaluation committee.
b) The financial bids of only those bidders will be opened online who are found technically responsive by the evaluation committee.
c) The manufacturers/ authorized distributors/dealers/suppliers/firms are advised to go through the technical specifications mentioned in the NIT.
3. **Pre-eligibility/Technical Conditions:**
Documents required for Pre-eligibility of Bid:
 - i. Copy of GST certificate.
 - ii. Copy of PAN/TIN Card of the concerned manufacturers/ authorized distributors/dealers/suppliers/Firms
 - iii. Undertaking of not being blacklisted by any Govt. Agency/ department.
 - iv. Complete address, email, phone number, bank details of the firm and a cancelled cheque.
 - v. Offers should be accompanied by a DD of Rs.1000/- (non-refundable) in favour of "**Comptroller, SKUAST-Jammu**" payable at Jammu towards the Tender fee and EMD of Rs.5000/-in the shape of CDR/FDR payable to Comptroller, SKUAST-Jammu.


Terms & Conditions/Instructions

1. No tender without cost of tender document (demand draft) and earnest money in the shape of CDR/FDR shall be entertained. The CDR/FDR of tenderers shall be released after the purchase process is over.
2. The earnest money shall be forfeited if any manufacturers/ authorized distributors/dealers/suppliers/firms withdraws his bid or tender during the validity period or there is failure of successful bidder to furnish the equipment and

- performance security within specified time period after issuance of letter of acceptance.
3. Each bid must be accompanied with the proof of Earnest Money and Tender Fee at the time of bidding and the scanned copy of the same be uploaded with the technical bid while tendering, failing which tender of the defaulter shall be rejected.
 4. To participate in bidding process:-
 - i. The bidders have to get Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) as per Information Technology Act-2000 to participate in online bidding.
 - ii. The DSC will be required for digitally signing the bid. The bidders can get above mentioned digital certificate from any approved vendors. The bidders who already possess valid DSC need not to procure new DSC.
 - iii. The bidders have to submit their bids online in electronic format with DSC. The bids cannot be uploaded without Digital signature. No proposal will be accepted in physical form.
 - iv. Bids will be opened online as per time schedule mentioned.
 - v. Before submission of online bids, bidders must ensure that scanned copies of all the necessary documents have been attached with bid.
 - vi. The department will not be responsible for delay in online submission of bids whatsoever reasons may be.
 - vii. All the required information for bid must be filled and submitted online.
 - viii. The details of cost of documents, EMD specified in the tender documents should be the same, as submitted online (scanned copies) otherwise bid will not be accepted.
 5. Any other information / clarification can be had from the office of the undersigned on all working days from 9:30 a.m to 5:00 p.m. and email id: deanfohfskuastj@gmail.com
 6. Conditional tenders shall be rejected out rightly.
 7. The envelope in which tender is submitted must be superscribed as "**Procurement of Spiegel Relaskop**" for which tenders have been submitted.
 8. The specifications of the **Spiegel Relaskop** should conform to the highest standards as per relevant BIS/ISO specifications.
 9. The competent authority i.e., SKUAST - Jammu reserves the right to revise or alter the specifications of the equipment before the acceptance of the tender.
 10. Late, delayed and incomplete tenders and amendments and additions other than submitted online will not be accepted.
 11. The successful tenderer shall be responsible for installation of the equipment and making it fully operational.
 12. The tenderer shall be fully responsible for the manufacture's warranty in respect of proper design, quality and workmanship of the equipment (s) accessories etc. covered by the tender for a period of 12 months from the date of satisfactory installation/commissioning of the system.
 13. The tenderers shall make provision for imparting training to our scientists/ maintenance staff on operation and use of Spiegel Relaskop and its accessories.
 14. The tenderer should enclose a certificate with the tender stating that
 - i) The equipment is of the latest technology.

- ii) The equipment shall be promptly and properly serviced by them whenever desired and such service will remain available to SKUAST-J for 01 year from the date of its installation.
15. Prices quoted by the bidder should be inclusive of transit insurance, freight, installation and commissioning at destination sites. Discount, if any, should be shown separately. Additional charges, if any, on account of Excise Duty, GST, VAT, Entry Tax or any other charge / levy must be specifically quoted.
 16. The offer should be valid for a period of 30 days from the specified date of allotment of the tender.
 17. 100% payment shall be made on installation and commissioning of the equipment. However, the tenderer shall have to furnish a bank guarantee equal to 10% of the total cost of the equipment towards performance guarantee for one year which shall be released on successful completion of the warranty period.
 18. The company must offer model fulfilling the tender specifications. The catalogue/brochure of the equipment model should be available on the firm/company website for online verification.
 19. The hard copy of tender documents including original copy of DD (cost of tender document) and CDR/FDR (EMD) must reach in the office of the **Head, Division of Silviculture & Agroforestry, FoH&F, SKUAST-Jammu, Main Campus, Chatha, Jammu-180009 (UT of J&K)** not later than the specified time as stipulated in the NIT, if the date on which the tenders are to be received / opened is declared as a public holiday, the tenders shall be received and opened on the next working day.
 20. The competent authority of SKUAST-J does not bind itself/himself to accept the lowest or any tender & reserve the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender or portion of the quantity offered and the bidders shall supply the same at the rate quoted.
 21. The payment shall not be processed unless and until the equipment has been delivered, installed / commissioned and accepted, in accordance with the conditions of the contract and to the entire satisfaction of the competent authority of SKUAST-J.
 22. All questions, disputes, or difference arising under and out of, in connection with the contract shall be subject to the Courts at Jammu (J&K).
 23. In case the materials supplied by the supplier/bidder are not found as per specifications mentioned in the tender notice and other certified documents, the same shall be rejected and supplier must lift the supplies at his own risk, responsibility and cost. Further, EMD of such supplier shall be forfeited.



Technical specifications of Spiegel Relaskop along with accessories

Measurement	CP Scale
Basal Area	m ² /hectare 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 16, 25, 49, 64, 81 BAF
Tree Diameter	Relaskop Units: Convertible to cm or inches*
Tree Height	%:-170 to +270 of horizontal baseline distance in any unit of measure
Vertical Angles	%:-170 to +270 Deg.: -60 to +70
Slope	%:-170 to +270

*On CP Scale models, each Relaskop Unit band (RU) equals a diameter which is 2% of the horizontal base line distance (e.g., at 18 m baseline, each RU=2% of 18m=36cm. A tree measuring 5RU's=5x36 cm = 180 cm).

Accessories: Ball Joint Adapter for attaching Spiegel Relaskop to Jacob Staff, Staff 54" in length with top that can be trimmed to accommodate mounting brackets from 0.65" to 1.1" in diameter; clear and frost replacement window. Leather case.


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
