SKUAST-Jammu had invited sealed bids on prescribed format fixed with revenue stamp of Rs. 5/- (Rupees five only) along with call deposit receipt (CDR) of Rs 5000.00 (Rupees Five Thousand Only) pledged in favour of "Comptroller, SKUAST-Jammu" from the intending persons/agencies/mills/firms for disposal of the following produce lying in Mega Seed Project of University Chatha. The auction date is further extended for a period of 15 days i.e., on or before 21st April 2025 upto 5.00 p.m. The sealed bids addressed to the "Chairman Auction Committee, SKUAST-J should reach in the office of Nodal Officer (Seed), Mega Seed Project SKUAST-J Chatha through registered post/speed post. The bids shall be opened on the next working day at 11.00 a.m. in Directorate of Research. The bidders may inspect the crop materials/lots lying at Mega Seed Project, SKUAST-J Chatha, on all working days before quoting rates. Terms and Conditions

1. Any offer without CDR shall not be entertained.
2. The rates should be quoted on per quintal basis
3. Conditional bids shall be rejected outrightly.
4. The quantities mentioned above are approximate and can vary.
5. **The weight of gunny bags shall be included in weight of the paddy.**
6. Envelope containing the bid amount be labeled as "Paddy Grain Basmati 370".
7. 80% amount of the accepted bids shall have to be deposited within three days of acceptance of the bid and 20% before lifting the material.
8. The successful bidders shall have to lift the grain within five days after depositing the full amount and issuance of authorization.
9. The successful bidder who fails to lift the auctioned materials within stipulated time, the next higher bidder shall be offered to lift the material in highest bid.
10. The University shall not be responsible for any kind of damage whatsoever thereafter.
11. The auction committee reserves the right to accept or reject any tender without assigning any reason thereof.
12. The bidder desirous of representing themselves on the opening of the bid can do so in person or through their authorized representative.
13. The bid for paddy grain shall not be below Rs. 3000/q.
14. The disputes, if any, shall be subjected to the jurisdiction of the Hon'ble Courts located in the Municipal Limits of Jammu city only.
