The programme was organised under the chairmanship of Dr. P.I. Gautam, Pro-Chancellor GB Pant University and Former Vice Chancellor GB Pant University of Agriculture & Technology, Pantnagar, in the presence of Prof. J.P. Sharma, Vice Chancellor SKUAST-Jamma and SKUAST-Kashmir, Dr. Sanjay Kumar, Director CSIR-HBT. Dr. Jag Paul Sharma, Director Research SKUAST-Jammu. On this occasion, two Memorandum of Understandings (MoUs) were also signed. First one was between MoU between SKUAST-Jammu & HIBT, Palampur that will help in exchanging technologies related to processing, value addition, floriculture and production of medicinal and aromatic plants.

Besides, microbiology, biotechnology and nanotechnology provides other attractive areas of research interests. Second one was between SKUAST-Jammu & Career Point University, Hamirpur that will strengthen ties related to

academic and research for the benefit of students and

Speaking on the occasion, Dr. P.L. Gautam appreciated the collaborative efforts of both the premium institutions from J&K and Himachal Pradesh for bringing larger benefits to the farmers of the region. Emphasizing upon the prevailing common agro-ecological situations in both J&K and Himachal Pradesh, he urged to converge standardized technologies across institutions for their horizontal expansion. He further expressed his concerns regarding low coverage of farmers under the prevailing insurance

scheme and suggested that awareness of farmers is the most essential part for providing risk coverage to farmers through insurance. Prof. J.P. Sharma Vice Chancellor SKUAST-Jammu discussed the administrative arrangements of Weather based insurance scheme and suggested for recording farmers' views and interests to float farmers oriented crop insurance scheme in J&K. He suggested to highlight the differences in farming practices and farmers' perspective on crop insurance to compare the scope of implementation of scheme in both the regions.
