Minutes of 24th meeting of Academic Council

The 24th meeting of the Academic Council was convened under the chairmanship of Dr. B.N. Tripathi, Honorable Vice-Chancellor, SKUAST-Jammu, on the 4th of December 2023, in the Conference Hall, SKUAST-J, Chatha. The list of participants is attached as Annexure-I. The meeting commenced with a warm welcome from the Registrar, SKUAST-Jammu, who extended greetings to the Chairman, Directors/Deans, and all members present. In his opening remarks, Dr. B.N. Tripathi, Honorable Vice-Chancellor, emphasized the pivotal role of faculty and students as the twin pillars on which the academic excellence of the university/institution rests. He highlighted that the contributions of these two entities have a direct impact on the university's ranking, stressing the need for collective efforts to elevate SKUAST-Jammu's standing in the NIRF ranking. Dr. Tripathi underscored the importance of the New Education Policy, which advocates the generation of practical training, skill development, and competent human resource. Traditional classroom practices, he noted, fall short of meeting these goals. Therefore, he urged faculty members to revamp their teaching methodologies, focusing on practical orientation, discussions, doubt clearing, assignments, and hands-on knowledge application. He further elaborated on the evolving role of a classroom, emphasizing that it should not be confined to merely delivering lectures but should serve as a dynamic space for interactive learning. He encouraged a shift towards a more engaging and participative learning environment, fostering a culture of continuous improvement. He conveyed confidence in the academic community of SKUAST-Jammu, expressing belief in their ability to embrace essential changes for the comprehensive development of both faculty and students.

The Registrar presented the agenda after seeking the approval from the Chairman. The following agenda items deliberated upon:

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 1 : Confirmation of minutes of 23rd Meeting of Academic Council

The Member Secretary apprised the house that the minutes of the 23rd meeting of the Academic Council held on 02-06-2022 were circulated among the members vide AUJ/Acad/ 2021-22/F-08/2132-82, dated 10-06-2022 (refer to Annexure-II). Dr. Rajinder Peshin, Controller of Examination, raised a concern about the University not issuing a notification regarding Agenda items AC (23)15 & 16, as per the resolution passed during the 23rd Academic Council meeting. All members unanimously agreed to confirm the minutes of the 23rd Academic Council meeting. Consequently, the House adopted the following resolution:

"Resolved that the minutes of the 23rd Academic Council meeting, as circulated vide AUJ/Acad/2021-22/F-08/2132-82 dated 10-06-2022, were confirmed."

Agenda Item No. AC (23) 2 : Holding of VIIIth Convocation of SKUAST-Jammu and award of Degrees therein.

The Registrar conveyed to the House that the University's VIIIth Convocation is scheduled for January 4th, 2024. The comprehensive list of graduates eligible for the award of degrees in the VIIIth Convocation is provided in Annexure-III. The assembly unanimously passed the following resolution:

"Resolved that degrees be conferred upon the graduates in various programmes of the University, as specified in Annexure–III, during the VIIIth Convocation. List of the recipients will subsequently be presented during the upcoming Board of Management Meeting."

Agenda Item No. AC (23) 3 : Award of Certificates of Merit & Gold Medals during the VIIIth Convocation.

The agenda under discussion focuses on the acknowledgment and awards for outstanding academic accomplishments by students in alignment with the University's regulations.

The Honorable Vice-Chancellor emphasized the significance of setting a high standard for the Merit Certificate, highlighting that it should be a testament to the students' dedication and hard work. The current threshold for conferring merit certificates, i.e., an OGPA of 8.0/10.00, was considered achievable by an average student. The house engaged in a comprehensive deliberation on the agenda, leading to the adoption of the following resolution:

"Resolve that

- i. The regulation for awarding Certificates of Merit to PG and Ph.D. programs will be revised to recognize students who secure an OGPA of 8.5 and above on the 10.00 scale. This regulation will undergo a review after two years.***

- ii. The list of pass-out students in PG programs & Ph.D., achieving an OGPA of 8.5 and above on the 10.00 point scale, is approved for the award of Certificates of Merit in the VIIIth Convocation of the University, as detailed in Annexure IV-A.*
- iii. Professor Arun Gupta Memorial Gold Medal will be awarded to the topper of the M.Sc. Programme in the discipline of Vegetable Science, in recognition of outstanding achievements in the field of Vegetable Science (Annexure IV-B)."*
- iv. Gold Medals will be conferred upon the toppers of B.Sc.(Hons.) Agriculture/ B.V.Sc. & A.H., and B. Tech Biotechnology programmes in the VIIIth Convocation of the University, as outlined in Annexure-IV-B.*

Award of gold medals will subsequently be presented during the upcoming Board of Management Meeting

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 4 : Modifications in the syllabus for B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture Degree Programme.

The Registrar informed the members about the issuance of a memorandum, referenced as AUJ/Acad./F- /22-23/4449-65 and dated 18/10/2022. The memorandum, based on the recommendations of the Dean of the Faculty of Horticulture & Forestry, outlined modifications to the syllabus and course curriculum of the B. Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture degree program. After thorough discussion, the following resolution was adopted:

"Resolved that the Memorandum no. AUJ/Acad./F- /22-23/4449-65 dated 18/10/2022, incorporating modifications in the syllabus and course curriculum of the B. Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture degree program, has been ratified."

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 5 : Implementation of Higher Education Opportunities for Private Sector/Agricultural Industry Employees

The University has received a communication dated 05.09.2022 from the Deputy Director General (Agri. Edn.), Indian Council of Agricultural Research, suggesting that Agricultural Universities may reserve 5% of seats on a

paid basis for Ph.D. programs dedicated to industry-sponsored candidates. These candidates should possess a minimum of 3 years of experience in Research and Development activities within the private industry. The matter was thoroughly deliberated in the house, and the following resolution was adopted:

"Resolved that the recommendations regarding Higher Education opportunities for private Sector/Agricultural Industry Employees be adopted. Consequently, one supernumerary seat in each discipline in self-financing category for industry-sponsored candidates is created under the Ph.D. program with the following conditions:

- i. Industry-sponsored candidates must be eligible and have a minimum of 3 years of experience in Research and Development activities within the private industry.***
- ii. Such candidates shall undergo the coursework and meet the minimum residential requirements.***
- iii. For such candidates, one of the co-advisors shall be from the industry."***

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 6 : Accreditation of Teachers /Scientists for Postgraduate Teaching/Research.

The agenda concerning the accreditation of Teacher/Scientists for Postgraduate Teaching/Research was presented before the house for discussion and deliberation. The Honorable Vice-Chancellor inquired about the current status of individuals holding the position of Assistant Professor in the university and the agenda was kept pending until the verification of their credentials as Assistant Professor/Junior Scientist is completed.

Agenda Item No. AC (24)7 : Make-up examination (Addition in sub-clause(f) under clause 6.2 Chapter of RRI 2020 of SKUAST

Dean FoA informed the house that the university currently allows makeup examinations solely on account of the death of a close relative and not for students unable to appear due to health issues. The matter has been deliberated and house unanimously resolved the following resolution:

"Resolved that the amendment is made to Sub-clause 6.2 in Chapter-6 of the Regulations on Resident Instructions-2020 of SKUAST-Jammu:

For UG students

- ***Normally, no make-up examination shall be allowed in lieu of the missed examinations. However, Head of Department may consider to allow make up examination only for missed Mid Term examination under the following very exceptional circumstances:***
 - i) Demise of mother, father, spouse, brother or sister***
 - ii) Student's own hospitalization on account of serious illness***
 - iii) Natural calamity in the home town/village.***
 - iv) Attending interviews conducted by PSC/SSB/ASRB or other recruiting bodies as approved by the Vice-Chancellor.***
 - v) If the student has been permitted attendance as per Academic Regulation***
- ***The Head of Department after being satisfied with the veracity of the reason(s) for missing the Mid Term examination may instruct the concerned Instructor to take make up examination under intimation to the Dean.***
- ***The application for makeup examination must be made by the student, through his/her Advisor and instructor to the Head of Department within 5 days of holding of the examination.***
- ***If the student fails to take the makeup examination within 15 days from the date of missed examination, he/she shall be awarded 'Zero' marks in that examination***

For PG students

- ***If a student misses an examination (other than the End Term examination) on account of illness or some other valid reason, he/she may petition, through the Advisor and the Instructor to Head of the Department concerned, within five days of the date of the said examination for permission to appear in a make-up examination. If illness is cited as the reason for absence from the examination, the petition shall be accompanied by medical certificate from the University Medical Officer or the Government Medical Officer. If***

Head of the Department is satisfied with the veracity of the reasons for missing examination, he may direct the Instructor to hold the make-up examination for the student and endorse copy of this order to the Registrar and Dean, Postgraduate Studies for being included in the student's personal file. It will be the responsibility of the student to get in touch with the Instructor and have a date fixed for the make-up examination. Such a student shall be required to take the make-up examination within a fortnight from the date of missed examination. In case more than one student has been allowed to take the make-up examination of the same course, the concerned Instructor shall fix a common date within a fortnight from the date of missed examination. However, if a student misses the make-up examination, he shall be awarded zero mark in the said examination.

- **Normally, no make-up examination shall be allowed in lieu of the missed End Term examination except under the following very exceptional circumstances:**
 - i) **Demise of mother, father, spouse, brother or sister.**
 - ii) **Student's own hospitalization on account of serious illness**
 - iii) **Natural calamity in the home town/village.**
 - iv) **Attending interviews conducted by PSC/SSB/ASRB/ or other recruiting bodies as approved by the Vice-Chancellor.**
- **The student who has missed End Term examination will apply to the Dean, Postgraduate Studies within three days from the date of missed examination through Course Instructor, Major Advisor and, concerned Head of Department. The Dean, Postgraduate Studies after being satisfied with the veracity of the reasons for missing the End Term examination, may instruct the concerned Instructor to return 'I' (incomplete) grade in that course with a copy to Registrar. Head of the Department and the Advisor.**

- *When 'I' grade is returned in a course, the Registrar shall declare the result of the student without taking into account that course. The result in that course shall be kept in abeyance till the Instructor is able to hold the special test and to return the final grade, which shall not be later than 30 days from the date of the missed examination.*
- *If the student fails to take the special test within 30 days from the date of missed examination, he/she shall be awarded 'F' grade in that course.*
- *On the receipt of the final grade, the Registrar shall issue the revised semester report in respect of that student.*

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 8 : Dress Code for Practical Crop Production Course

The matter regarding Dress Code for Practical Crop Production Course (Agron. 312 and Agron. 323) offered by the Division of Agronomy, ensuring uniformity and ease of working in the field was deliberated in the house and following resolution was adopted:

"Resolve to adopt the dress code for Practical Crop Production Course for B.Sc. (Hons) Agriculture/ B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture includes to the following:

Dress code

- ***Grayish blue track suit/dress***
- ***Saw cap with strip and University emblem engraved in the front:***
- ***The concerned Dean is responsible for paneling the appropriate agency for the supply of the prescribed dress items. The Dean shall assess and select a reliable agency that can provide high-quality dress items meeting the specified requirements.***
- ***Expenditure Borne by Students:***

- ***The expenditure related to the procurement of the dress items shall be borne by the concerned students. Each student enrolled in the specified courses is required to cover the cost of their dress items. The exact cost and payment details shall be communicated to the students by the concerned department."***

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 9 : Proforma for Evaluation of Masters and Ph.D Students

The Director of Education informed the assembly that, due to the adoption of the regulation of BSMA, the evaluation pattern for Masters and Ph.D. programs has been revised. Consequently, a new proforma for the evaluation process is deemed necessary. The matter was discussed in the meeting, and the following resolution was adopted:

"Resolved that the revised proforma for the Evaluation of Masters and Ph.D. be approved (Annexure-V)"

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 10 : Conduct of Comprehensive Examination for Ph. D. Programmes

The Registrar informed the house that, subsequent to the adoption of BSMA regulations, a comprehensive oral examination by an external expert remains mandatory for Ph.D. programs. However, there are currently no specific guidelines regarding the completion of coursework when applying for the oral comprehensive examination. The Honorable Vice-Chancellor emphasized the importance of maintaining written comprehensive examinations, as they provide in-depth knowledge and enhance students' competitiveness. Prof. Peshin, Controller of Examination, provided context by highlighting that before the adoption of BSMA regulations, the University followed written comprehensive examinations for both Masters and Ph.D. programs. After a thorough discussion, the following resolution was proposed for adoption:

"Resolved that Comprehensive Written examination followed by viva voce for Ph.D. is mandatory from the academic session 2023-24 with the following guidelines:

- i. There are two written papers of Major-I and Major-II.***
- ii. If a student fails in the written Comprehensive examination, he/she is eligible to appear again after three months.***

- iii. *For Oral examination, if the student fails, he/she will again appear after 03 months*
- iv. *If a student fails again, then he/she may repeat in the next semester."*

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 11 : Marks distribution in Supplementary examination

The matter was discussed by the house, and after thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted.

"Resolved that supplementary examination is done for both practical as well as theory examination"

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 12 : Assignment of Course Number RPE-601 for "Research & Publication Ethics for M.Sc. & Ph.D programmes.

The matter was discussed by the house, and after thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted.

"Resolved that the course no RPE-601, course title "Research & Publication Ethic is allotted to the students of Ph.D programmes."

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 13 : Re-admission of the dropped-out students

The matter was discussed by the house, and after thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted.

"Resolved that the re-admitted students shall register only for those courses which have been offered to regular 1st year class"

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 14 : Inclusion of Experiential Learning Course on Skill Development in Natural Farming

The Registrar conveyed that ICAR has sanctioned an Experiential Learning Course on Skill Development in Natural Farming to the Centre for Organic and Natural Farming, Faculty of Agriculture, Main Campus, Chatha,

SKUAST-Jammu. To seamlessly integrate this valuable course into the elective courses offered during the 7th semester of the undergraduate students pursuing the B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture program, the matter was discussed by the house.

After thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

"Resolve that:

- ***The ELP Model titled "Experiential Learning on Skill Development in Natural Farming" be approved for inclusion in the 7th-semester elective courses of the B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture program.***
- ***The course content will cover practical aspects, including:***
 - ***Bio pesticide/bio control agent preparation***
 - ***Plant Extracts' preparation***
 - ***Preparation of liquid manures: Sanjivak, Jivamrut, Amritpani, Panchgavya, Beejamrut, etc.***
 - ***On-farm compost making/compost fortification***
 - ***Seed treatments***
 - ***Product quality analysis"***

**Agenda Item No. AC (24) 15 : Involving RAWE students in Soil Health Card &FPO activity
(as per Action Taken Report on point No. 7 or the Cabinet
Note)**

The matter was discussed in the meeting, and the following resolution was adopted:

"Resolved that activities related to Soil Health Cards and Farmers' Producer Organizations (FPOs) be included for one week in the RAWE program."

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 16 : To Treat the period spent on international training programme or national internship by students being undertaken under IDP-NAHEP, SKUAST-Jammu by UG students at par with routine course work during the period of their deputation.

The Directorate of Education informed the house about the participation of undergraduate students in international training programs or national internships under the Institutional Development Plan - National Agricultural Higher Education Project (IDP-NAHEP), SKUAST-Jammu. The matter was placed for appraisal and ratification.

"Resolved that the period spent by undergraduate students on international training programs or national internships under IDP-NAHEP, SKUAST-Jammu, be ratified and treated as equivalent to routine coursework/ internship during the period of their deputation."

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 17 : Inclusion of course NSS in B.Tech.(Agricultural Engineering) from batch-2023

Dean, faculty of Agricultural engineering stressed that for inclusion of NSS course as per the approved four years B.Tech. Programme in Agricultural Engineering operational in SKUAST-J. Dean, Dairy Technology also proposed, the same may be followed in B.Tech Dairy Technology too. The matter was discussed by the house. After thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

"Resolved that CoCA-111 2(0+2) and CoCA-121 2(0+2) courses as compulsory for the batch i.e. 2023 of B.Tech (Agricultural Engineering) and B.Tech Dairy Technology onwards."

Agenda Item No. AC (24)18 : Changes in the existing UG course curriculum of FoA / FoH&F / FoAE / SBT

Registrar informed the house that changes in the existing Undergraduate (UG) course curriculum of FoA, FoH&F, FoAE, and SBT. The nature and specifications of these changes are documented in the following courses as detailed below:

The matter was discussed by the house. After thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

"Resolved that modification in the existing Undergraduate (UG) course curriculum of the Faculty of Agriculture (FoA), Faculty of Horticulture and Forestry (FoH&F), Faculty of Agricultural Engineering (FoAE), and School of Basic Sciences (SBT) at per (Annexure-VI) be adopted."

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 19 : Enhancement of Internship allowance

The Dean, Faculty of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry (F.V.Sc. & A.H.) informed the house that the internship allowance for our B.V.Sc. & A.H. students is currently Rs. 6000/month. This amount was increased from Rs. 6,000/- to 18,000 per month in 2018. However, the internship allowance in many state/central veterinary/agricultural universities across the country is significantly higher.

The matter was discussed by the house, and after thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

"Resolved that

- i. The internship allowance for the Final year B.V.Sc. & A.H. students of this university be enhanced from Rs 6000 to Rs 18000/month.***
- ii. The Dean, F.V.Sc. & A.H. shall explore the possibility of an industry-scientist interface to meet the expenses of the internship.***
- iii. The Dean, F.V.Sc. & A.H. shall propose enhancement in the fee structure to meet the expenses.***

iv. The matter may please also be referred to Board of Management (BoM).

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 20 : Proposal for Upgradation of Faculty of Basic Sciences to Faculty of Basic Science and Humanities

The Dean of the Faculty of Basic Sciences (F.B.S.) submitted a comprehensive proposal for the strengthening and re-designation of the existing Faculty of Basic Sciences. The Honorable Vice-Chancellor suggested that the said proposal requires some modification and further discussion in detail.

Hence, the agenda item was deferred for subsequent discussion and consideration.

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 21 : Engaging Professor of Practice (PoP) in Universities and Colleges per NEP-20, UGC norms.

The matter was discussed by the house, and after thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

“Resolved that a committee shall be formed to study the feasibility of Engaging Professor of Practice”

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 22 : Admission to UG, PG, Ph.D programme for 1st semester/1st Year of academic session 2022-23.

The matter was discussed by the house and after thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

“Resolve that the admission granted to various Ph.D programmes through SKUAST-J CET (UG, PG, Ph.D for the Academic session 2021-22, 2022-23 be approved.

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 23 : Relaxation in residential requirement and adoption of multiple entry/ exit in Agricultural Universities-reg.

Dr. S.E.H., Rizvi, Director Education apprised the house that ICAR has constituted 6th Dean committee for the revision of course Curriculum for Under-graduate programme as per NEP-2020 & multiple entry/ exit in Agricultural Universities and same shall be followed in SKUAST-Jammu. The matter was discussed by the house, and after thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

The agenda has been deferred till the outcome of committee of ICAR

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 24 : Institution of B.Sc. (Hons.) Natural Farming.

The matter was discussed by the house, and after thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

The agenda has been deferred

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 25 : Admission to M.Sc. (Agri.) Molecular Biology and Biotechnology under DBT-PG Programme.

Coordinator, School of Biotechnology informed that SKUAST-Jammu for admitting ten (10 Nos.) of students in M.Sc. (Agri.) Molecular Biology and Biotechnology under DBT-PG programme based on score of Graduation Aptitude Test Biotechnology (GAT-B)-2023 conducted by DBT. The Programme of M.Sc. (Agri.) Molecular Biology and Biotechnology under DBT shall be run under school of Biotechnology with normal fee, i.e. Rs. 28800/- for 1st semester and Rs. 14125/- for recurring semesters (without hostel fee) further, the intake of 10 seats under DBT-PG programme is over and above University programme of M.Sc. (Agri.) Molecular Biology and Biotechnology.

The matter was discussed by the house, and after thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

“Resolved that

- Institution of M.Sc. (Agri.) Molecular Biology and Biotechnology under DBT-PG Programme in the School of Biotechnology, SKUAST-Jammu be approved.***

- ***The fee shall be normal fee i.e. Rs. 28800/- for 1st semester and Rs. 14125/- for recurring semesters (excluding hostel fee) for M.Sc. (Agri.)***

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 26 : Amendment in Clause- 4.5.3(b) Chapter 4 of RRI of SKUAST-Jammu -2020.

The matter was discussed by the house, and after thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted

“Resolved that a student found using unfair means during the final examination shall be failed in the course in which he/she is found using unfair means, if the student has indulged in such practice for the first time. If the student is found using unfair means for the second time, he/she shall be failed in all the courses he/she has offered in that semester”.

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 27 : Enhancement of Registration Fee of B.V.Sc. & A.H Students for Undergoing Internship Programme

Dean, F.V.Sc. & A.H, R.S.Pura informed that for the enhancement of Registration Fee of from Rs. 1000/- to 6200 for B.V.Sc. & A.H Students for Undergoing 12 months Compulsory Internship Programme as charged by the SKUAST-Kashmir. The matter was discussed by the house, and after thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

“Resolved that registration fee of B.V.Sc. & A.H. students during undergoing internship programme be enhanced from Rs. 1000/- to Rs.6200/- from the Academic session 2023-24”.

Agenda Item No. AC (24) 28 : Course content of VPE-613 entitled “Research Methodology and Publication Ethics in VPE”

Head, Division of Veterinary Public Health and Epidemiology informed that course no: VPE-613 (Research Methodology and Publication Ethics in VPE) with credit hours of 2+0 is designated as core course for Ph.D in Veterinary Public Health and Epidemiology in the revised syllabi of Postgraduate Programmes published by

ICAR in 2021. The matter was discussed by the house, and after thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

“Resolved that Research Methodology and Publication Ethics RPE-613 (1+1) is offered to PhD programmes across all discipline of faculties as a mandatory course.”

Additionally, the Board of Management (BoM) has passed a resolution supporting the up-gradation of the School of Biotechnology. house expressed unanimous support for the proposal and directed the relevant authorities to include the agenda in the upcoming Statutory Body meeting for further discussion.

IX. Eligibility criteria at Graduation level for Faculty of Faculty of Dairy Technology, Agricultural Engineering, and School of Biotechnology

The Registrar briefed the attendees on the recent approval by the Government of the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir to establish three new faculties at the University: the Faculty of Agricultural Engineering, Faculty of Dairy Technology, and Faculty of Horticulture and Forestry. Concurrently, the government has sanctioned posts for the cadre of Dean, Professor, Associate Professor, and Assistant Professor within these faculties. The university is currently in the process of formulating recruitment rules for these positions. The matter was discussed by the house, and after thorough deliberation, the following resolution was unanimously adopted.

: Guidelines for engagement of Adjunct Faculty

In order to avail the short-term expertise from outside the system, wherein services of distinguished Indian scientists/ teachers / technologists from within the country and abroad shall be utilized on a short-term assignment / contract on whole time basis, the matter was deliberated upon and following resolution was adopted for engagement of adjunct faculty :

REQUIREMENT:

The Adjunct faculty shall be engaged from the active/retired, eminent academician/scientist/ engineer/ manager having recognition at national and international levels with outstanding publications and rich experience in teaching and /or research organizations.

2. PROCEDURE FOR NOMINATION OF ADJUNCT FACULTY

- a) The Head of the Division of the concerned disciplines shall identify specific teaching/***

research needs of the discipline.

- b) The proposals along with the recommendations of Board of Study (BOS) of concerned discipline should be forwarded to Director Education for examination by the Standing Committee for further consideration of the Academic Council.*

3. COSTS AND HONORARIUM

- a) An honorarium of Rs. 2000/- per lecture, subject to the maximum of Rs. 60,000/- per year.*
- b) The Institute may provide travel charges as per rules and accommodation in the university Guest House. In case of long distance travels, the number of visits may be kept as minimum by suitably arranging the lectures.*
- c) The Adjunct Faculty shall have privileges with regard to access to library services and digital learning resources.*

4. OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- a) The Adjunct Faculty shall be nominated for a period of maximum 2 years only.*
- b) The Adjunct Faculty shall deliver at least 10 lectures per year in the relevant discipline on issues of topical interest, which shall be coordinated by the Head of the concerned division.*
- c) Number of Adjunct Faculties in a discipline shall not exceed two in a given point of time.*
- d) At the end of two years, nomination shall be submitted by the concerned Head of the division along with the 'performance report' of the Adjunct Faculty for extending the term of Adjunct Faculty. Maximum of two terms of 2 years each shall be permitted".*

Agenda Item No. AC (23) 6
